Team quota accordance with IFSC rules 2012 part 12.4 "Registration of competitors"

- 12.4.1 Member federations may register up to a maximum of five (5) team officials who shall be granted free entry into the competition venue. These officials shall be named on the official IFSC registration form and specifically nominated for one of the following roles:
- One (1) team manager;
 - Two (2) team coaches;
 - Two (2) qualified medical or para-medical personnel.
- 12.4.2 Subject to Article 12.2.1, member federations may register on the official IFSC registration form a National Team comprising (where applicable):
- Any current Adult/Youth World/Continental Champion (who shall be registered for the Discipline in which they are champion); and
 - In addition to (a), a further five (5) competitors for each Category and Discipline of the competition.
- 12.4.3 The presence of all persons registered pursuant to Articles 12.4.1 and 12.4.2 must be confirmed:
- By the attendance of at least one team official or competitor at the competition venue at the hour specified on the information sheet provided by the Organiser; or
 - By SMS to the IFSC Delegate and/or the Jury President, not later than the time specified on the information sheet provided by the Organiser, only where exceptional circumstances such as strikes, traffic delay, etc. prevent attendance in person.

ACCREDITATIONS

All team officials registered on the IFSC website will have a free access pass for all the duration of the competition.

On the request of the Team Manager, at the registration on Tuesday 11th, a free access pass for accompanying people (one per competitor of the national team) will be given to competitors.

No other pass will be given after this moment.
