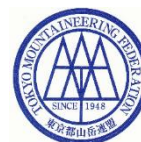

## COMPETITION FORMAT

Outdoor Village Speed Stars 2018 is composed by 3 2 rounds as below.

- ~~a. Pre-Qualification~~
- a. Qualification
- b. Final

All participants ~~except the invited athletes must join Pre-Qualification round on 28<sup>th</sup> April and Top 14 athletes are qualified for Qualification round on 29<sup>th</sup> April.~~ The quota for Final round is **between 4 (four) to 16 (sixteen).**

## INVITED ATHLETES

Event Organiser invites a total of twelve (12) top athletes (six (6) athletes in each category) except host country. The invited athletes are exempt from Pre-Qualification round. They are selected by following procedure.

- a) In principle maximum of two (2) athletes from one (1) country in each category
- b) Current World Record Holders in each category
- c) Top 3 athletes of World Games 2017 in each category except criteria b)
- d) Top 2 athletes of current World Ranking in each category except criteria b) and c)
- e) Best athletes from Host country in each category

If the invited athlete(s) selected by this procedure cancelled to participate, Event Organiser would select another invited athlete(s) from World Ranking holders. In this case criterion a) is excluded.

The invited athletes except criterion e) can receive 100,000 JPY as their reward to the participation. They can stay at the official hotel (HOTEL FOREST INN SHOWAKAN) by free of charge from 27<sup>th</sup> April to 2<sup>nd</sup> May (maximum of 5 nights and 6 days). Please note that the Event Organiser DOES NOT PAY any air fare and ground transportation fee for the invited athletes.

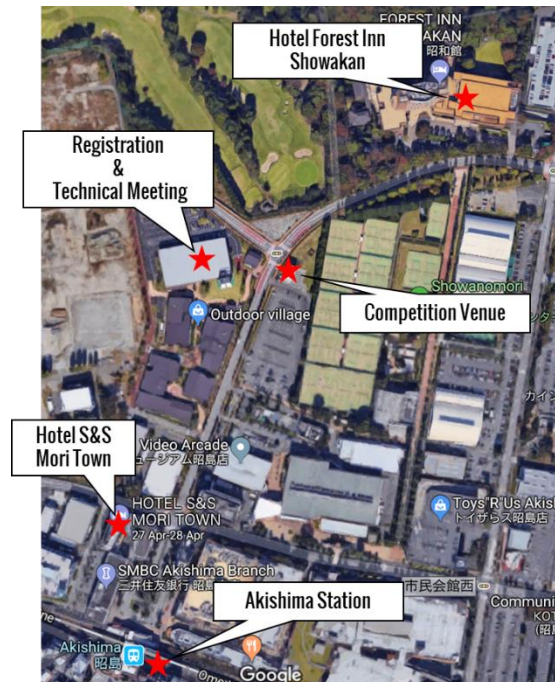
